Dear Tribal Health Leaders,

On behalf of the Department of Health (the department) and in keeping with the responsibility to conduct tribal consultation, I am writing to inform you of a proposed future Medicaid state plan amendment (SPA). <u>This opportunity for consultation runs concurrently with public comment on proposed regulations.</u>

Purpose and content of the proposed amendment:

The department intends to submit a SPA to update attached sheet to attachment 3.1-A, attachment 3.1-L (alternative benefit plan), and attachment 4.19-B of the Alaska Medicaid State Plan to reflect the addition of advanced practice dental hygienists as Medicaid billing providers.

Anticipated impact on Medicaid-eligible Alaska Native/American Indian beneficiaries:

The department anticipates the addition of the advanced dental practice hygienist provider type will increase access to appropriate and timely services for all Alaskans, including American Indian and Alaska Native beneficiaries.

Anticipated impact on tribal health programs and the Indian Health Service:

Tribal health programs may experience some benefit through increased provider availability for beneficiaries requiring services outside the tribal health system.

Mechanism and timeline for comment

Written comments or questions regarding the proposed amendment are due no later than the close of business, November 27, 2023. If seeking an in-person meeting regarding the proposed changes, please provide a written request within 15-days of the date of this letter.
