Dear Tribal Health Leaders,

On behalf of the Department of Health (the department) and in keeping with the responsibility to conduct tribal consultation, I am writing to inform you of a proposed future Medicaid state plan amendment (SPA).

Purpose and content of the proposed amendment:

The proposed amendment intends to maintain the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) related suspension of fee-for-service behavioral health service authorization requirements, approved via 5/12/2024 (AK SPA 23-0007), until the effective date of the forthcoming state plan amendment, outlined in the March 19, 2024, tribal consultation letter.

The continued suspension of these service authorization requirements is anticipated to be temporary, providing the department time to implement proposed regulations modifying service authorization requirements.

Anticipated impact on Medicaid-eligible Alaska Native/American Indian beneficiaries:

The department anticipates this proposed SPA will positively impact Medicaid-eligible Alaska Native/American Indian beneficiaries as the SPA will maintain the reduction of barriers to services between 5/12/2024 and effective date of the forthcoming SPA and aligned regulations.

Anticipated impact on tribal health programs and the Indian Health Service:

The department anticipates the proposed SPA will positively impact tribal health programs as it will prevent increased administrative burden and barriers to care until the forthcoming SPA and aligned regulations are finalized.
