Dear Tribal Health Leaders

On behalf of the Department of Health (the department) and in keeping with the responsibility to conduct tribal consultation, I am writing to inform you of a proposed future Medicaid state plan amendment (SPA).

Purpose and content of the proposed amendment:

This proposed amendment intends to maintain the temporary, enhanced COVID-19 Public Health Emergency professional pharmacy dispensing fees, approved through 5/11/2024 (AK SPA 23-0008), until the effective date of the forthcoming, proposed, interim dispensing fees. These interim dispensing fees were shared in the tribal consultation letter disseminated on April 26, 2024.

Anticipated impact on Medicaid-eligible Alaska Native/American Indian beneficiaries:

The proposed SPA does not impact Medicaid-eligible Alaska Native/American Indian beneficiaries.

Anticipated impact on tribal health programs and the Indian Health Service:

The proposed SPA will positively impact tribal health programs as it ensures there is not a decrease of the reimbursement rates for the tribal pharmacy dispensing fees prior to the effective date of the interim pharmacy dispensing fees.
