

- Care Coordination Agreements required for non-emergent transportation claims
 - Refocus on referrals
- Streamlining the validation process

 - Scheduled implementation: July 1, 2018
- Other Health Home Opportunities
 - Coordinated Care Demonstration Projects
 - Other reform initiatives

Pioneer Homes

- Requires payment assistance applicants to apply for Medicaid
- Impact of budget cuts
 - 38 full and part time positions eliminated
 - 25 beds held vacant
- Timing
 - Miller's Trust Application
 - Waiver Application Process
 - Level III Residents require the highest level of care
- Analyzing Process and Savings

Emergency Dept. Care Improvement

FY2017	FY2018	On Track?
\$4.8	\$42.6	Yes

- Alaska State Hospital & Nursing Home Association is the lead
 - Alaska Chapter of the American College of Emergency Physicians
- Real-time information exchange
 - Emergency Department Information Exchange (EDIE)
 - 4 Providence hospitals went live in February
 - · Anchorage, Kodiak, Valdez and Seward
- Established uniform statewide guidelines for prescribing narcotics
 - 10 hospitals agreed to logo on guidelines
 - Important tool to reduce opioid abuse in Alaska

Fraud & Abuse Prevention

(\$401.9)	(\$556.2)	Delayed

- Allows the department to assess interest and penalties on any identified overpayment
- Requires providers to conduct self-audits every two years
- Fraud and Abuse Inter-Department committee

 - Third party vendor
 - Annual savings must exceed the cost of implementing the system
- ARIES Release 2 delayed
 - Federal 18F team on site to assist
 - Developing plan for Release 2

Behavioral Health System Reform

- Comprehensive behavioral health reform
 - Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority partnership
- Section 1115 Waiver to provide flexibility in Medicaid coverage and payment policies
 - Concept Paper submitted to CMS January 4, 2017
 - Application to CMS July 2017
 - Milliman providing actuarial consulting and analyses
- Administrative Services Organization (ASO) contract to support systems of care
 - Released Request for Information 2/27/17

Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

- Dept. of Commerce, Community & Economic Development is the lead agency
- Registering with the database
 - Drug Enforcement Agency number
 - Dentists, Physicians, ANPs, Optometrists, Pharmacists
- Medicaid Pharmacist access
- Exemptions when prescribing or dispensing schedule II or III controlled substances
- Submit data on at least a weekly basis
- Tribal health practitioners access
- Guidelines for the prescription of Schedule II controlled substances

Privatization Studies

- API privatization feasibility study
 - Public Consulting Group (PCG)
- DJJ privatization feasibility study
 - Carter Goble Lee, Inc. (CGL)
- RFP for the Pioneer Homes pharmacy privatization study was released twice
 - Both times the offeror was deemed non-responsive

EXPLORING OPTIONS

Health Care Authority

- Dept. of Administration is the lead agency
- Study the feasibility of creating a Health Care Authority to coordinate or consolidate state health care purchasing
- PRM Consulting Group selected
 - 1st Phase: Survey of employee health benefit programs
 - 2nd Phase: Includes Medicaid
 - DHSS met with PRM 12/16/16
