## Alaska Traditional High School Survey

## Sample Description:

School Level - All regular public schools containing grades 9, 10, 11, or 12
with enrollments of ten or more were included in the sampling frame.
Schools were selected systematically with probability proportional to enrollment in grades 9 through 12 using a random start. 43 schools were sampled. One of the sampled schools was ineligible.

Response Rates:
Class Level - All classes meeting during a particular period of the day were included in the sampling frame. Systematic equal probability sampling with a random start was used to select classes from each school that participated in the survey.

## Response Rates:

Schools -95\% 40 of 42 sampled schools participated
Students - 65\% 1,331of the 2,031 sampled students submitted questionnaires.
1,327 questionnaires were usable after data editing.
Overall response rate -95\% * 65\% = 62\%

## Special Note:

Because the overall response rate equaled or exceeded the 60\% threshhold, the data were weighted and are representative of the entire student body.

## Sample Description:

Primary Sampling Units (PSUs) - From 1,276 PSUs, consisting of counties, subareas of large counties, or groups of smaller, adjacent counties, 57 were sampled with probablility proportional to overall school enrollment size for the PSU.

School Level - Schools with any of grades $9-12$ were sampled with probability
Class Level - Included a random sampling from each of grades 9-12, one or two classrooms from either a required subject (e.g., English or social studies) or a required period (e.g., homeroom or second period).
