





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

Background BRFSS

- Purpose Collection and dissemination of data
- Duration of BRFSS 1991 present
- Survey coverage All 50 states (and some territories)







Background BRFSS

- Standard Survey Core, Optional Modules, & State-Added Questions
- Supplemental Survey







Methods BRFSS

- Ongoing telephone survey
- Sample design stratified random sampling
- □ Sample size 2,500 minimum
- Weighting (and "raking")
- □ CASRO response rates ≥60%
- Limitations

- Conduct collaborative analyses

Background YRBS

- Purpose Collection and dissemination of data
- Conducted biennially (in odd-numbered years)
- Duration 1995, 1999 (excluding Anchorage), 2003
 - present
- Survey coverage
 - 47 states + territories and cities/regions (2015 survey)
- Questionnaire
 - 114 questions (2017 Alaska YRBS)









Methods YRBS

- Administered in schools
 - Participants Students in grades 9-12
 - Four simultaneous surveys
- Sample design Several strategies
- Sample size
- Response rates
- Weighting
- Limitations





 - Ad hoc requests












Who uses YRBS data and how?
