

Alaska Department of Health Free COVID-19 Test Ordering for Partners

For Organizations

Free over-the-counter (OTC) COVID-19 test supplies are currently available for bulk ordering by organizations through the Federal Test Distribution Program, while supplies last. Ordering units start at 1 package (464 test kits) for Access Bio CareStart and 1 package (240 test kits) for Sekisui OSOM.

How to Order:

Organizations without an existing Health Partner Ordering Portal (HPoP) account:

- 1. Please contact your local public health center for local availability of tests. You can find your local public health center here. In Anchorage, contact the Anchorage Health Department at AHDClinicalServicesOutreach@anchorageak.gov or call 907-855-9186.
- 2. If you are a large healthcare facility such as a large or multi-site Tribal Health Organization, hospital or long-term care facility and do not have a HPoP account, please contact the Alaska Department of Health directly at doh.dph.epi.hpop@alaska.gov for HPoP onboarding. Allow 3-5 days for response. Outpatient and assisted living facilities should first reach out to their local public health center for available tests.

Organizations with an existing HPoP account:

Applicable to only organizations currently onboarded to the COVID-19/Diagnostic module in HPoP.

How to Submit a COVID-19 Test Order:

- 1. Sign in at https://hpop.hhs.gov
- 2. Navigate to Site Orders/Inventory section.
- 3. Make sure you are in the Orders tab.
- 4. Click Create Order in the top right corner of the screen.
- 5. Select COVID-19/Diagnostic.
- 6. Select the Test Brand you wish to order.
- 7. Select the Quantity.
- 8. Review your order.
- 9. Once you have reviewed your order and are ready to proceed, click Submit Order.

For CLIA-certified facilities or those with a CLIA Certificate of Waiver, reporting positive COVID-19 results isn't required for OTC test kits distributed for off-site use. Reporting is required if the test is administered or results interpreted by someone else at the organization, rather than self-administered. For full details, see OTC Home Testing and CLIA: FAOs

For Individuals

In late September 2024, all U.S. households will be eligible to order up to four additional COVID-19 test kits at no charge. You can place your order at <u>COVIDTests.gov</u>. These tests will detect current COVID-19 variants and are valid for use through the end of the year.

Test Expiration Dates Extended. The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has extended the shelf-life of some at-home tests. <u>Check test expiration dates here.</u>
