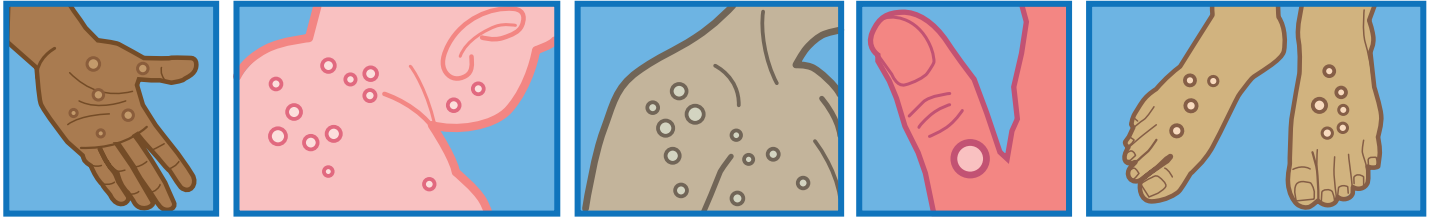

MPOX



Mpxo is a viral infection that can be transmitted through close, personal contact with mpxo rash, scabs or body fluids from a person with mpxo. A rash that may be painful and itchy and look like pimples or blisters may appear near the genitals or anus, or on the hands, feet, chest, face or mouth.

AVOID

- Skin-to-skin contact with mpxo rash, scabs or lesions.
- Respiratory secretions from prolonged, face-to-face contact with an infected person (i.e. from kissing).
- Prolonged contact with items such as clothing or linens, that previously were in contact with an infectious rash.



Wash your hands often with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
