

ABOUT THE PREPMOD TRAINING COURSE

The PrepMod Training Course was developed in partnership with the State of Alaska (SOA) and Area Health Education Center (AHEC) at the College of Health at the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) to offer several online trainings relating to PrepMod, the electronic tool that assists in the logistical coordination of vaccine clinic scheduling, clinic operations, vaccine record maintenance, and POD events.

AVAILABLE TRAININGS

Once registered for the **COVID PrepMod Training Course**, users can self-enroll into the appropriate training(s). Currently, the PrepMod 101 Training is available for enrollment. Other trainings will be made available soon.

PrepMod 101 Training: This training is oriented toward Provider Administrators and will provide foundational instruction to assist in creating and managing a clinic from start to finish. Other staff (such as Venue Admin, Lead Staff, etc.) may also benefit from this training.


REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Course registration is managed through AHEC's Continuing Education platform through the UAA College of Health. Registration is open and available to those who are offering or participating in vaccination clinics or are interested in utilizing PrepMod. Once registered, a tutorial video is available to orient users to navigating Blackboard and the course structure.



- Select the blue REGISTER NOW button in the COVID PrepMod Training course informational page (shown right).





COVID 19 PREPMOD TRAINING COURSE

- 2. The course should appear in the shopping cart. *There is no cost to participate in this course.* Select the **CHECK OUT** button.
- 3. Following check out, there are two registration pathways:
 - **RETURNING ASAP Users** can enter their username and password to login. Follow the prompts to fully complete the registration.
 - If the password is unknown or forgotten, click the green DON'T KNOW YOUR
 PASSWORD? button for quick password reset steps.
 - NEW ASAP Users will need to click CREATE NEW ACCOUNT and fill in the required fields.
 Follow the prompts to fully complete the registration.
 - Personal email accounts tend to work best with this system, as agency-related addresses may be blocked.




- Upon successful registration, the confirmation page (shown right) will appear. An autogenerated email with this same information will be delivered shortly after submission.
 - Be sure to check spam or junk folders for this email.

- Expect an additional email within two business days that contains login and password information to access the course platform, Blackboard.
 - If this second email does not arrive within two business days of registration, please reach out to Pat at <u>plsammartino@alaska.edu</u> for further assistance.
- Once the login credentials are emailed, users can access the course through Blackboard. https://classes.alaska.edu/
 - Users may want to create a unique password based on the steps provided in the emailed instructions.
- Upon logging into Blackboard, locate the COVID PrepMod Training course in the course menu.
 Open the course by clicking on the course title.
