Craig Public Health Center is staffed with public health nurses (PHNs II-III), and an Office Assistant, and provides high quality Public Health Nursing Services to 9 communities over 10,875 square miles. Services are provided in clinics, homes, community meetings, shelters, schools, and even outdoors.

In FY 15, <u>Craig Public Health Center</u> provided:

- 1,359 individual visits
- 958 immunizations
- 497 visits to children, many of whom had no other access to care
- 62 visits related to sexually transmitted diseases
- Provided 196 individual visits to screen for tuberculosis.

Broad-based work:

- Participated in 79 community events to promote health and prevent disease, impacting at least 9,302 community participants
- Responded to 61 referrals from community providers.
- Leading in community events for island wide immunization coverage for all ages for flu, PCV-13, Zoster and TDAP.
- We respond to daily requests for assistance from community agencies on infectious diseases, and access to health care questions.
