Immunization Requirements for School Compliance

Before Admission to School, the Parent/Guardian Must:

Provide an immunization record from a physician, health department, or other health care provider showing dates (month, day, year) of required immunizations



All Students PreK-12th Grade

All students PreK through 12th grade must receive at least one dose of the following vaccinations or be compliant in an appropriately spaced series to start school:

- DTaP/DT/Td/TdaP
- Polio
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- MMR vaccine
- PreK children must also have at least one Hib vaccine
- Preschool-6th grade students must also have at least one dose of Varicella
- Adolescents age 14-15 yr olds are required to have a TdaP Booster

(History of disease must be documented on the state form by a medical provider (MD/DO/ANP/PA)

Not Required but Recommended

Vaccinations **NOT REQUIRED** for school but recommended by CDC and the American Academy of Pediatrics:

- COVID-19 Vaccination currently 12 yrs and older
- Influenza Vaccination annually
- HPV Vaccination age 11 yrs and older
- Meningococcal Vaccination age 11 yrs and older
- Rotavirus Vaccination series
- Pneumococcal conjugate series
