(Outside of Anchorage & Mat-Su areas)



Do you have concerns about a child's development?

The Outreach Clinics bring Pediatric Neurodevelopmental Specialists, and their teams, to Alaskan communities for problem-focused medical assessments, evaluations, and diagnoses of infants and children (10 months - 9 years) who may have a range of neurodevelopmental conditions. They have a specialized focus on autism. They also provide impressions, treatment considerations, recommendations, and follow up. When necessary, they will make referrals for further evaluation at an appropriate diagnostic center.

Because of COVID-19, and the restrictions on travel and face to face visits, the Neurodevelopmental Outreach Clinics will be using a telehealth model for the fall of 2020. The appointments will be held using a secure telehealth platform to connect families with the Neurodevelopmental Specialists and Parent Navigator. Families will be provided instructions and guidance on how to connect with the platform and how to optimize their neurodevelopmental telehealth appointment and follow-up.

Areas we will give priority to for the fall 2020 clinics:

Juneau, Kenai, Bethel, Kotzebue, Nome, Ketchikan, Fairbanks

Other patients from outside of Anchorage and Mat-Su will be added based on space.
