- Follow up emails sent to Legislators, providing the GCDSE Annual Report, and 4 Priority Position Papers as attachments.


Position Papers Presented:

 - Decrease chances of contracting Covid-19, and dying


- Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Cost Saving
