

#### **DD Council Role:**



- Disability Pride awareness events promote visibility and mainstream awareness of the positive pride felt by people with disabilities.






Message from Heidi...

- Completion of next State 5-Year Plan (Due end of September 2021)
- Trust Reporting (October 2021)
- ACL Living Well Semiannual Reporting (October 2021)
- New 5-Year Plan begins (October 1, 2021)
- ACL Living Well Carryover (December 2021)
- Program Performance Reporting as DD Council and State Plan Update (usually December 2021, now January 21, 2022)
