REQUEST FOR SPECIALIZED PROGRAM ACTIVITY

This form is required when a child care facility is seeking to offer a moderate-risk activity, as identified in child care licensing regulations. A separate form and supporting documentation must be submitted and approved by the department for each activity your facility would like to provide.

7 AAC 57.810. Specialized program activities. (a) A child care facility may not provide a program of moderate-risk activities on a regular basis unless the facility has approval by the department for a specialized program activity. Moderate-risk activities include specialized program activities such as gymnastics, swimming, camping, wilderness walks, horseback riding, canoeing, skiing, climbing, fishing, skateboarding, rollerblading, scooter riding, and bike riding.
