Xarelto available 10mg, 15mg, and 20mg tablets Eliquis available 2.5mg and 5mg tablets

INDICATIONS and USAGE:

XARELTO:

" XARELTO is a factor Xa inhibitor indicated:

- to reduce the risk of stroke and systemic embolism in patients with nonvalvular atrial fibrillation
- for the treatment of deep vein thrombosis (DVT), pulmonary embolism (PE), and for the reduction in the risk of recurrence of DVT and PE
- for the prophylaxis of DVT, which may lead to PE in patients undergoing knee or hip replacement surgery"¹

ELIQUIS:

"ELIQUIS is a factor Xa inhibitor anticoagulant indicated to reduce the risk of stroke and systemic embolism in patients with nonvalvular atrial fibrillation."

Criteria for Approval:

Atrial Fibrillation (XARELTO OR ELIQUIS)

- Diagnosis of non-valvular atrial fibrillation; AND
- Documented treatment failure of warfarin or clinically significant medical reason for non-trial of warfarin

Deep Vein Thrombosis or Pulmonary Embolism (XARELTO)

- Treatment of deep vein thrombosis, pulmonary embolism and reduction in the risk of recurrence of DVT and of PE; AND
- Documented treatment failure of warfarin or clinically significant medical reason for non-trial of warfarin

Hip or Knee Replacement Surgery (XARELTO)

Prophylaxis of deep vein thrombosis (DVT) for knee or hip replacement surgery

Length of Authorization:

- 1. Non-valvular atrial fibrillation, prior authorization may be approved up to 12 months (Xarelto/Eliquis)
- 2. Treatment of DVT, PE; prior authorization may be approved up to 12 months (Xarelto)
- 3. Prophylaxis of Deep Vein Thrombosis: (Xarelto)
 - a. Hip and knee replacement surgery, Date of Service

Dispensing Limit:

- 1. Prophylaxis of Deep Vein Thrombosis with a **Quantity Limit** of 1 dose per day:
 - Hip replacement surgery up to 34 days supply
 - Knee replacement surgery up to 12 days supply
- 2. The dispensing limit is a 30 day supply of medication with a **Quantity Limit** of 2 tablets per day (*Eliquis*)
