



Alaska Vaccination Coverage Report

Quarter 2, 2026

To decrease the risk of acquiring potentially serious vaccine-preventable diseases, Alaskans are recommended to stay up-to-date with all recommended vaccines.

Methods: Vaccination coverage rates are assessed quarterly based on VacTrAK data. This report includes data as of June 30, 2026. Vaccines were selected based on commonly used metrics for vaccine compliance, including the 7-vaccine series for children aged 19-35 months (Childhood Series), the school-required vaccines for 5-6 year olds (Kindergarten Series), and human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine for adolescents between the ages 13-17 years.

The childhood vaccination rates for the 7-vaccine series in Alaska is 55%, among the lowest in the nation.¹

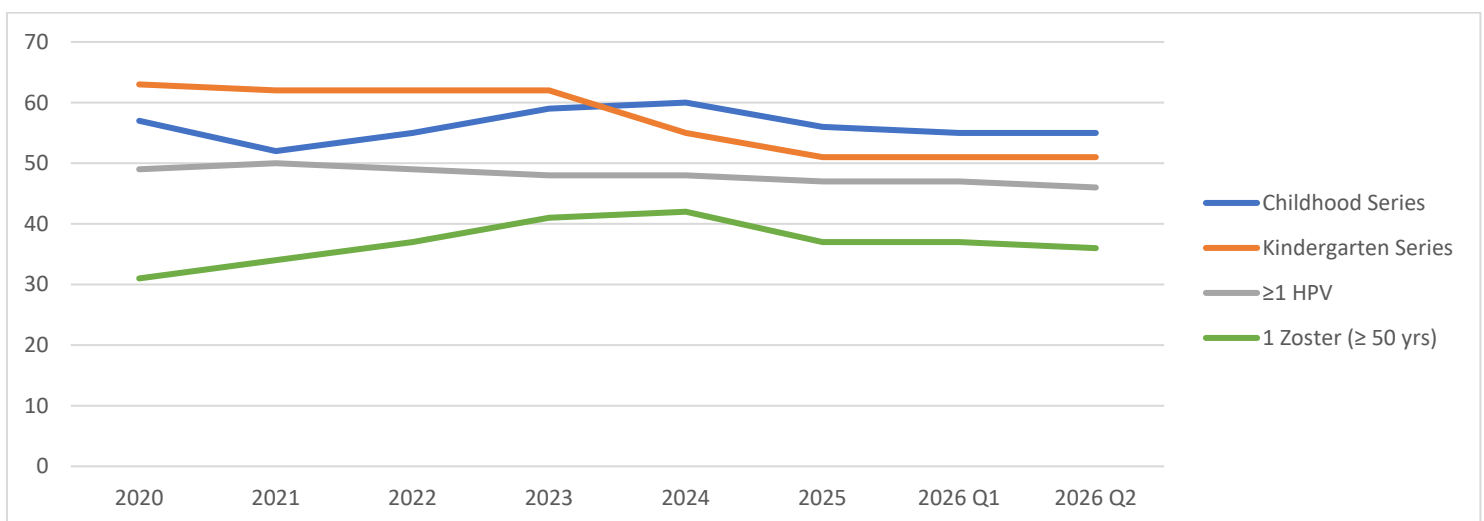
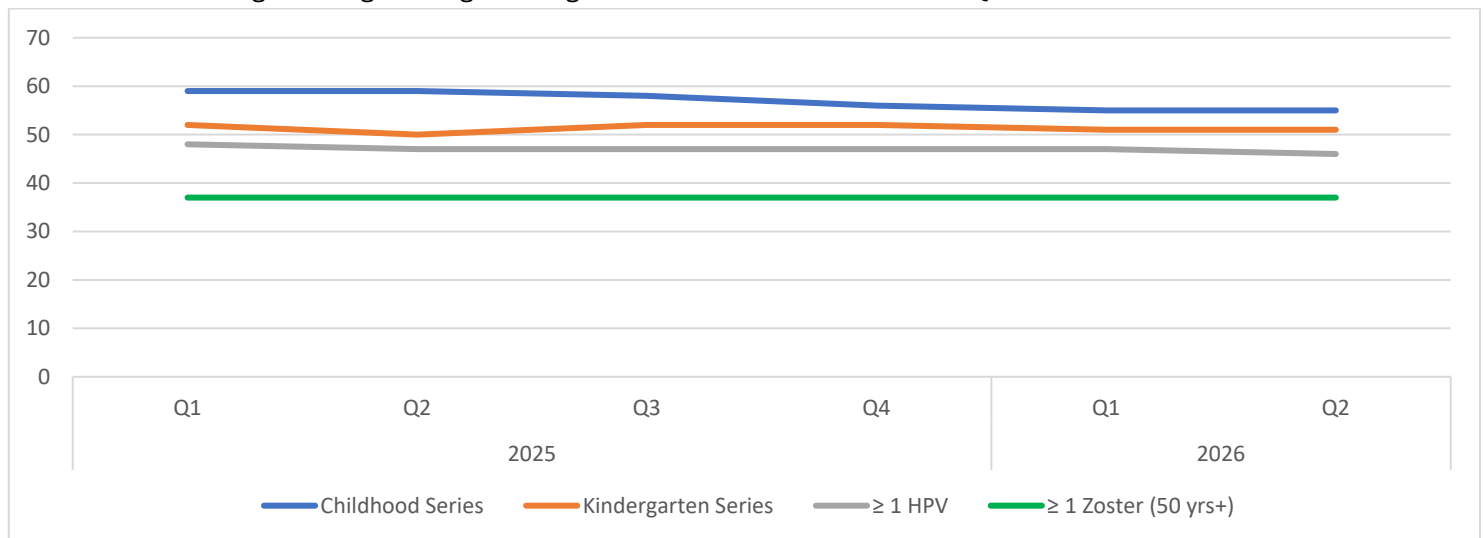


Figure 2: Vaccination coverage of select vaccines/series by quarter

Vaccination coverage among kindergarten-aged children remained stable in Q2.

Figure 3: Vaccine series coverage rate (%) by Alaska region, Q2 2026

Vaccination rates vary by region and age group. During 2026 Q2, Anchorage had the highest rates for childhood immunizations. The Northern region had highest coverage rates among kindergarten ages.

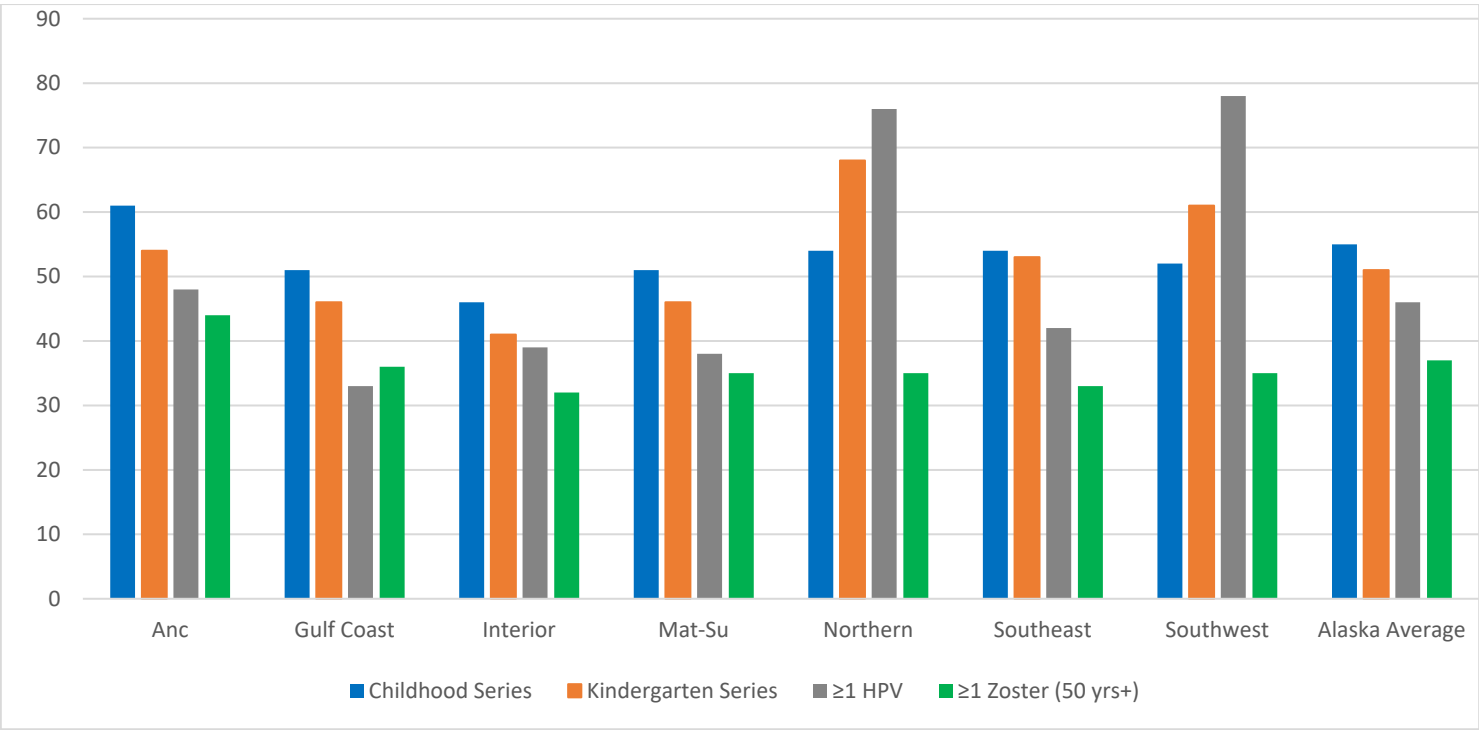
