

MEDICAID CHANGES ARE COMING.

Certain people and children are exempt from Work and Community Engagement requirements.

You are likely not affected if you:



Are **pregnant** or within the postpartum coverage period



Are a **veteran** with a total disability rating



Are **Alaska Native** or **American Indian**



Are a **parent/caregiver** for a child under age 14 or someone with a disability



Are **medically frail**, like having a significant physical, intellectual, or developmental disability, are blind, or have a serious complex medical condition



Have been **recently incarcerated** (within 90 days)



Are experiencing a **substance use condition**



Are under age 26 and **formerly in foster care**



Are enrolled in **Medicare**



Meet **SNAP** or **TANF** work requirements



Additional exemptions for Alaska



Living in an area with high unemployment
Unemployment rate 6.45% or above



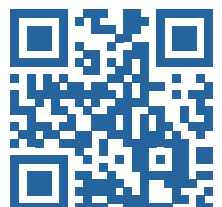
Living in a federally declared disaster area
Affected by a disaster



Receiving inpatient or residential care
In hospital or care facility



Traveling for medically necessary care not locally available
Getting care outside your area



You may need to provide documents that show you qualify for an exemption.

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
