DICLEGIS®(doxylamine succinate and pyridoxine hcl)

Available Delayed Released 10mg/10mg tablet

INDICATIONS and USAGE:

DICLEGIS is a fixed dose combination drug product of doxylamine succinate, an antihistamine, and pyridoxine hydrochloride, a Vitamin B6 analog, indicated for the treatment of nausea and vomiting of pregnancy in women who do not respond to conservative management.

Limitations of Use

DICLEGIS has not been studied in women with hyperemesis gravidarum.

Criteria for Approval:

1. Diagnosis from the 'Indication and Usage' section; **AND**
2. Documented trial and failure of at least one conservative management regimen for nausea and vomiting.

Length of Authorization:

Coverage may be approved for 3 months.

Dispensing Limit:

The dispensing limit is a 30 day supply of medication with the following **Quantity Limit** of 4 doses per day.
