About Lab Online LabOnline is a secure web portal that interfaces with the Alaska State Public Health Laboratory Information System and enables authorized laboratory users to order tests and receive test results, as well as download and/or print reports.

- LabOnline was tested on Internet Explorer 11; Microsoft Edge, and Google Chrome browsers.
- The minimum screen resolution for LabOnline is 1024 x 768 pixels. The maximum screen resolution for LabOnline is 1920 x 1080 pixels.

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Facility Access Requirements

1. You must coordinate your user access requirements, and user access parameters, with your Alaska State Public Health Laboratory Contact or Sponsor.
2. You must immediately discontinue use of any of your Facility's computers or electronic devices that show signs of being infected by a virus or other malware and report the suspected incident.
3. You must use ensure your Facility only accesses lab results for which you have been granted authorization.
4. You must ensure that your Facility uses only currently supported browsers such as Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge, or Google Chrome.
5. Within 48 hours, communicate any employment status changes to the ASPHL that eliminate your employee's need for access to LabOnline.
6. Review your Facility's employees' access to LabOnline every 30 days, and report any access status changes to the ASPHL.
7. Recognize that ASPHL will monitor use of the web portal by individual users and that laboratory reports can be modified solely by ASPHL.
8. You must report all security incidents or suspected incidents (e.g., hacked accounts or computers with access, improper or suspicious acts) related to LabOnline to hss-security@alaska.gov.
