## SMART MEDICAL CLEARANCE FORM

## **COVER SHEET**

The <u>SMART Medical Clearance form</u> was developed by emergency medicine and psychiatry specialists and uses an evidenced-based algorithm to implement a standardized and streamlined medical clearance process. The purpose of the SMART form is to standardize the process of transferring between providers in Alaska, eliminate barriers to admission, and reduce testing that is not medically indicated.

The SMART form can be used in <u>any</u> admissions/transfer.

This optional cover sheet includes information specific to psychiatric admissions in Alaska.
