The Alaska Rural Health Transformation Program (RHTP) is a multi-year investment designed to improve health outcomes and strengthen the long-term sustainability of Alaska's rural health system across each of Alaska’s 30 boroughs and census areas.

Project awards are being announced on a rolling weekly basis.

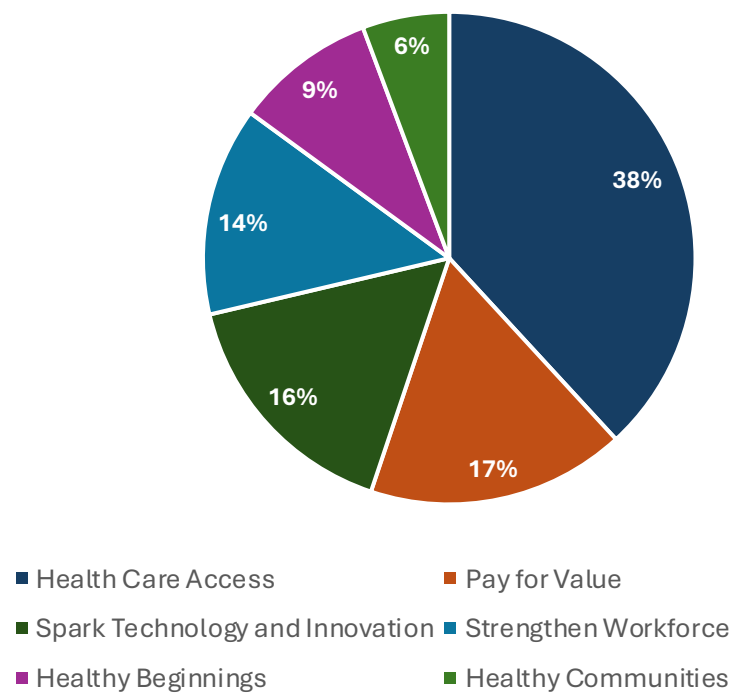
