



## Department of Health Learning Opportunity and Outreach Updates

### Impact Series

Rural Health Transformation Program (RHTP) Impacts is a new interactive webinar series convening partners from across Alaska to collaborate within the six RHTP initiatives:

Healthy Beginnings	Pay for Value: Fiscal Sustainability
Health Care Access	Strengthen Workforce
Healthy Communities	Spark Technology and Innovation

These sessions are designed to spark dialogue, strengthen partnerships, and build momentum for meaningful, lasting improvements in Alaska's health system.

RHTP Impacts includes six separate webinar series, one for each RHTP initiative, scheduled monthly. Each series brings stakeholders together to share ideas, learn from real-world examples in Alaska and beyond, and collaboratively tackle challenges and design practical solutions.

Sessions are structured to build over time, beginning with shared vision-setting, followed by focused discussions on priority challenges, partnerships, and potential projects, and concluding with key takeaways and next steps. ### Regional Planning Meetings

The purpose of these meetings is to convene local health providers, community organizations, Tribal partners, and other stakeholders to discuss regional gaps and challenges, identify transformative opportunities across RHTP priority areas, and define clear regional priorities. Outcomes include shaping regional priority areas, identifying key health service gaps, and developing actionable strategies and aligned metrics.

Participants in these one-day convenings can expect a data-driven regional landscape analysis, facilitated discussions, and opportunities to collaborate with DOH and subject-matter experts. The target RHTP meeting locations include Seward (April 29<sup>th</sup>), Kenai Peninsula (April 30<sup>th</sup>), Fairbanks (early May), Aleutians, Anchorage, Bethel, Dillingham, Kotzebue, Nome, Southeast Alaska, Utqiagvik, and others.

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
