97154	Adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician under direction of qualified health care professional to multiple patients	\$9.04	15 minutes
97155	Adaptive behavioral treatment with protocol modification administered by qualified healthcare professional to one patient	\$29.78	15 minutes
97156	Family adaptive behavioral treatment guidance by qualified healthcare professional (with or without patient present)	\$18.69	15 minutes
97157	Multiple-Family Group Adaptive Behavior Treatment Guidance, administered by QHP (without the patient present), face to face with multiple sets of guardians/caregivers	\$7.47	15 minutes
97158	Group Adaptive Behavior Treatment with Protocols Modifications, administered by QHP face to face with multiple patients	\$11.91	15 minutes
