



What is VacTrAK?

VacTrAK is the web-based Immunization Information System (IIS) from the Alaska Division of Public Health Immunization Program. It is a confidential, population-based registry that maintains immunization information for Alaskans of all ages.

VacTrAK allows you to:

- Obtain consolidated immunization records for your patients.
- Reduce staff time spent searching for records.
- Forecast future immunizations needed based on ACIP recommendations.
- Print official immunization records to meet school & childcare requirements.
- Manage vaccine inventory.
- Apply to receive state-supplied vaccine for eligible patients.
- Improve the accuracy of your immunization data.
- Generate automated reminder/recall notices for your patients.
- Assess immunization completion rates at your facility.

All health care providers are required to report administered immunizations to VacTrAK, the State of Alaska Immunization Information System, within 14 days of administration. The reporting requirement is applicable for all vaccines (state-supplied and privately purchased), all patient ages (children and adults), and includes documentation of dose-level eligibility status in VacTrAK. How do I sign up?
