| 80061 | 160 | Lipid Panel – Laboratory panel in which the level of cholesterol and triglycerides are measured |
| 81003 | 50 | Urinalysis Automated without microscopy – Urine sample with dipstick testing |
| 81025 | 70 | Urine Pregnancy Test – Urine sample is tested for the presence of HcG (Pregnancy Hormone) |
| 83036 | 140 | Glycosylated Hemoglobin Test – Hemoglobin A1C to determine average blood glucose levels over last several months |
| 85025 | 130 | Complete Blood Count w/ Automated Differential WBC – tests different components of blood for infection & oxygenation ability |
| 85651 | 55 | RBC Erythrocyte Sedimentation rate, non-automated – tests how far red blood cells fall in 60 minutes, used to detect inflammation in the body |
| 87804 | 90 | Influenza Assay w/ Optic – Rapid test for flu with direct visual observation |
| 87811 | 150 | SARS-COV-2 COVID 19 Antigen Test – Rapid Antigen test to determine if a person is infected with COVID-19 |
| 87880 | 90 | Strep A Assay w/ Optic – Rapid test for Strep A with direct visual observation |

| 90471 | 75 | Immunization Administration – Administration of vaccination |
| 90658 | 75 | Influenza Vaccine – Administration of split virus influenza vaccine, which provides protection against seasonal influenza |
| 90714 | 75 | Tetanus and Diphtheria Toxoids (Td) – Vaccine for Tetanus and Diphtheria |
| 90715 | 85 | Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Toxoids (Tdap) – Vaccine for Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis |
| 93000 | 205 | Electrocardiogram Complete – Test of heart electrical rhythms while at rest |
