Suicide Attempt Data Summaries






Nonfatal Suiciderelated Emergency **Department Visits** Alaska 2020-2023

- Data is collected from Alaska's Syndromic Surveillance platform.
- Relevant visits are identified using a mix of ICD-10 codes and keywords targeting suicide attempts, though other suicidal behaviors may also be included.
- Analysis focuses on non-fatal cases only.
- Participation in syndromic surveillance is voluntary, and not all hospitals participate.
 - Efforts in 2022 increased participation among tribal hospitals, leading to more hospitals onboarded.
 - Increases in visit counts in April 2022 are mainly due to onboarding efforts.
- Syndromic Surveillance data is based on queries of emergency department notes and diagnosis codes, which may lead to mis-categorization.





Alaska Emergency Department Visits Related to Suicide Attempt Statewide (2020-2024)





Alaska Emergency Department Visits Related to Suicide Attempt Statewide (2024)





Rate of Suicide-Attempt Related ED Visits per 1,000 ED Visits, Alaska, 2020-2024






Rate of Suicide Attempt-Related ED visits per 1,000 ED visits by Gender, Alaska, 2020-June 2024










Rate of Suicide Attempt-Related ED visits per 1,000 ED visits by Region, Alaska, 2020-June 2024


Alaska Suicide Mortality Data

- Data is from Alaska Vital Statistics 2023
 Annual Report (prepared by the Health Analytics and Vital Records Section, Division of Public Health, Alaska Department of Health) and CDC WONDER database.
- Vital statistics are collected from a vital record database containing death, birth, fetal death, and other vital events, and uses U.S. standard certificate forms for data collection.





Age-Adjusted Suicide Rate in AK and USA (2014-2023)




Crude Suicide Death Rate by Age Group (2018-2023)



Age-Adjusted Suicide Rate by Gender (2018-2023)






Age-Adjusted Suicide Rate by Race/Ethnicity (2018-2023)








Crisis Contact Center Data

- <u>Careline Crisis Services, Inc</u> is Alaska's crisis contact center, with locations in Fairbanks and Wasilla.
- Careline's crisis counselors answer calls to their direct line (877-266-4357) and calls/texts/chats routed from 988.
- Data is collected from Careline's Quarterly Data reports.
- Demographic information is based on caller voluntarily providing information themselves (and is never required to be reported by any caller).






Total Calls Routed to Careline in 2024


Yearly Careline Contacts 2015-2024







Yearly Careline Contacts by Aggregated Age Groups* 2015-2024



Yearly Careline Contacts Answered by Gender* 2015-2024










Yearly Careline Contacts Answered by Race* 2015-2024



Top 5 Presenting Issues for All Contacts 2024


