## Well-Child Transportation Program

Is your child eligible for Denali KidCare, or do you receive Medicaid because you are pregnant? If yes, you may be eligible for transportation services to get you to and from your medical appointments through the Alaska Medicaid Well Child Program.



## Who is eligible to receive services?

Children under age 21 and pregnant women who are currently eligible for Medicaid or Denali KidCare

## How do I request transportation services?

Contact the Well-Child Transportation Program (also known as EPSDT or Early Screening Program) by email, telephone, or fax and provide the following information:

- Name of person needing transportation, and escort if person is a minor
- Medicaid ID number and date of birth of the person needing transportation
- Date transportation assistance is needed
- Where you will need transportation from and to (including physical addresses)
- Your home physical address (and mailing address if you wish to receive a bus pass by mail)

Transportation assistance includes taxi rides, bus passes, or gasoline reimbursement to and from medical, dental, and WIC appointments. Available modes of transportation vary upon your location.

One business day advance notice is required to facilitate most transportation requests. Business hours are Mon - Fri 8:00am to 4:00pm. Be sure to contact us in advance to allow for mailing if you are requesting a bus pass by mail.
