# DICLEGIS® (doxylamine succinate and pyridoxine hcl)

Available Delayed Released 10mg/10mg tablet

#### **INDICATIONS and USAGE:**

DICLEGIS is a fixed dose combination drug product of doxylamine succinate, an antihistamine, and pyridoxine hydrochloride, a Vitamin B6 analog, indicated for the treatment of nausea and vomiting of pregnancy in women who do not respond to conservative management.

## Limitations of Use

DICLEGIS has not been studied in women with hyperemesis gravidarum.

## Criteria for Approval:

- 1. Diagnosis from the 'Indication and Usage' section; AND
- 2. Documented trial and failure of at least one conservative management regimen for nausea and vomiting.

## Length of Authorization:

Coverage may be approved for 3 months.

#### **Dispensing Limit:**

The dispensing limit is a 30 day supply of medication with the following **Quantity Limit** of 4 doses per day.
