RYBIX ODT® (TRAMADOL HCL)

Available 50mg, orally disintegrating tablets

INDICATIONS and USAGE:

"RYBIX ODT is indicated for the management of moderate to moderately severe pain in adults." 1

Criteria for Approval:

- 1. Recipient age is 17 or older; AND
- 2. Accumulative tramadol dose does not exceed 400mg/day. *If being co-administered with other products containing tramadol (Tramadol IR, Tramadol ER, Tramadol/acetaminophen) then dispensing limit may be reduced to not exceed 400mg/day*; AND
- 3. Trial and treatment failure of immediate release tramadol; OR
- 4. Recipient has documented inability to swallow or medical rationale that requires the ODT formulation over the immediate release oral tablets.

Length of Authorization:

• Coverage may be approved up to 6 months

Dispensing Limit:

• The dispensing limit is a 30 day supply of medication with the following **Quantity Limit** of 8 doses per day. If tramadol ODT therapy is being co-administered with another tramadol regimen, the dispensing limit is up to a total of 400mg of tramadol per day. (Example: tramadol ER 300mg daily, then the dispensing limit of tramadol ODT would be up to 2 daily for a total of 400mg a day)
