CRITERIA FOR APPROVAL:

- 1. The patient is HIV positive; **AND**
- 2. The patient is currently receiving or has recently received antiretroviral therapy; AND
- 3. The patient has lost 10% or more of their body weight; **AND**
- 4. The patient has had more than 30 days of diarrhea²; **OR**
- 5. The patient has had more than 30 days of weakness and fever.²

CRITERIA CAUSING DENIAL:

- 1. The patient is not HIV positive; **OR**
- 2. The patient is not receiving, or has not recently received, antiretroviral therapy; **OR**
- 3. The patient is being treated for any condition other than wasting or cachexia as defined above.

LENGTH OF APPROVAL:

1. Criteria may be approved for up to 6 months.
