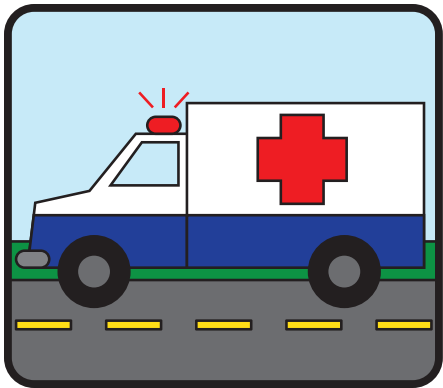
This resource is a communication tool for pre-hospital emergency care providers and their patients (designed with young children, non-verbal children and children with special needs in mind).
