Alaskans 65+ may schedule appointments beginning January 6, 2021

Online Scheduling

Alaskans 65 years of age and older will be eligible to start scheduling appointments starting at 12 pm on *Wednesday, January 6, 2021* by visiting <u>covidvax.alaska.gov</u>.

Appointments will be available for Alaskans 65 years of age and older beginning *Monday, January 11, 2021*.

How to Book

Step 1:	Starting January 6, 2021, visit <u>covidvax.alaska.gov</u>

- **Step 2:** Click on the button to "Locate a provider to schedule an appointment."
- **Step 3:** Search for a vaccine provider in your community with vaccine appointment availability starting January 11 or later. Appointments may be limited at first, and more will be added as they become available.
- **Step 4:** Schedule an appointment using the information provided. Your provider will advise you on how to make your appointment for your second dose.
