## Identifying adult doses incorrectly marked as VFC eligible in VacTrAK

The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program provides federal funding for the purchase of vaccines for eligible children age 0 through 18 years. VFC eligibility categories <u>cannot</u> be used for <u>persons age 19</u> years and older.


**Instructions** are below on how to run a *Patient Detail Report* in VacTrAK which will assist you to identify adult doses incorrectly marked as VFC eligible. To comply with Dose Accountability for VFC, these doses will need to be corrected by your site.

Certifying providers, vaccine coordinators and back-up coordinators are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of vaccine administration eligibility determinations and documentation. Staff training is an important part of maintaining compliance with state and federal requirements.


